

RAFFLES



EVERY SATURDAY NIGHT

Raffles is conducted by a member of THE LION Richlands staff at reception. Staff will organise the setup, sale of tickets, drawing of tickets and draw announcements.

Raffle ticket sales commence on a Sunday from 10am. Prices are as follows:

- \$2 for 1
- \$5 for 3
- \$10 for 8
- \$20 for 18
- \$30 for 30
- \$45 for 50
- \$80 for 100

A total of 40 draws will be held every Saturday night. Winners will picked from Raffletix.com.

Patrons can click the link they received when purchasing their raffle tickets to view the winners after 7pm every Saturday.

If a winning patron is in the club at the time of the draw, they will have first selection of the prizes available. If a patron is not at the club, they will win any prizes left over.

Prize breakdown below:

- 16 x Hamper varieties (each \$50 \$60 in value)
- 12 x Gift card varieties (each \$40 in value)
- 8 x \$50 Butcher vouchers (Moey's Butcher Springfield)
- 2x \$40 Club vouchers
- 2 x \$50 Cash prizes

*The first \$100 of every week's raffle takings will go towards our current month's charity

All details, including the winner's name, membership number and winning ticket are to be recorded. When a patron collects their raffle prize, they are to sign the raffle recording sheet. OLGR requirements states that the raffle sheet must contain a raffle ticket start number and end number. All takings must be recorded on the raffles reconciliation sheet provided.
